

TONBRIDGE SCHOOL FENCING COACH

Part-time - Term time (Michaelmas & Lent Terms only)

Tonbridge School Fencing Club seeks a coach to replace Maitre Christopher Penney who is retiring after nearly 20 years training Tonbridge fencers. We are looking for a competent and qualified Fencing Coach to manage all aspects of fencing coaching, using all three weapons.

The Club meets on Tuesdays, Thursday and Saturdays in the Christmas and Lent terms for 2 hours.

There is a full programme of inter-school matches and fencers enter county and section competitions and the Public Schools' Fencing Championships. Recent seasons' results:

Numbers in the club have varied between 25-35. Most start as beginners in year 9 or 10 and represent the school in matches as soon as their progress permits. The school provides all clothing (which all conforms to the safety standards set out by the BFA) and all weapons and there is an ample supply of both; senior fencers are, however, encouraged to buy their own kit.

Practice sessions and matches take place in the Tonbridge School Centre Studio which has three pistes permanently marked and several sets of scoring equipment can be deployed with sufficient lame jackets and wires/masks for all fencers to be fully equipped. A member of the teaching staff administers the organisation of the club and maintains the kit.
